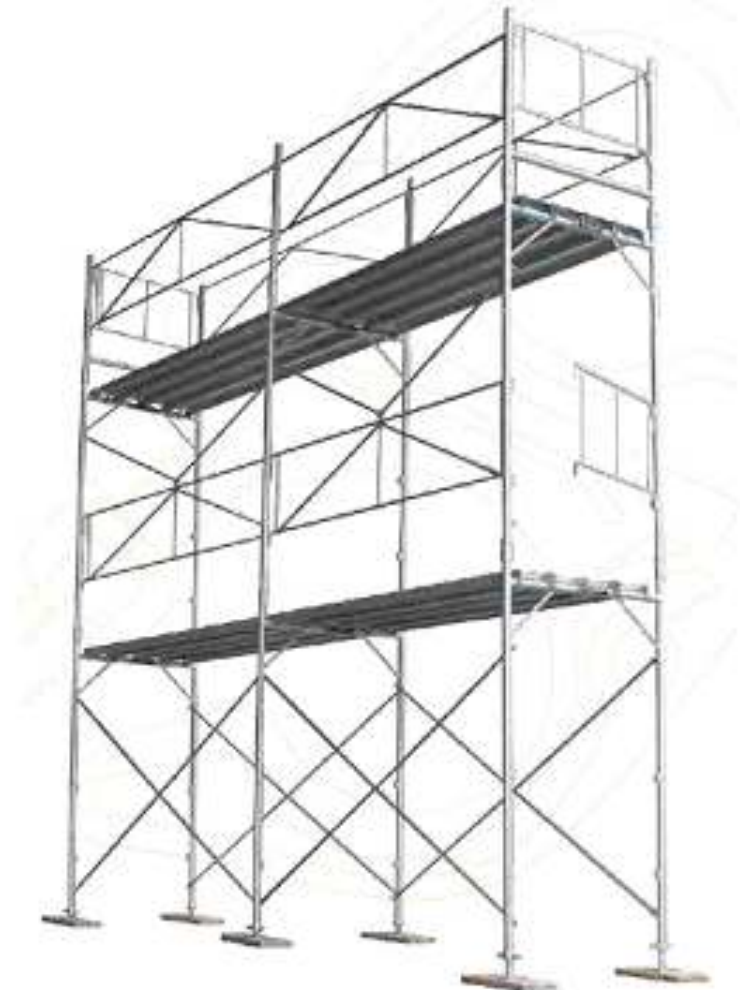

## Safety

Your safety is our primary concern so please read the following tips when using your scaffolding:

- Remember to **BE AWARE** a fall from any height can cause serious injury.
- Avoid using the scaffold in adverse **WEATHER** conditions as the tube and decking will become slippery if wet or icy.
- **LIFT ONLY TO YOUR CAPABILITY**
- Ensure your scaffold is **SECURED** properly before use.
- Watch when erecting scaffolding for **OVERHEAD** hazards (Phone Lines and Power Lines, falling materials etc.)
- Always use properly **SECURED AND FITTED** ladders and/or stairs to access all scaffolding
- Always **VISUALLY CHECK** the scaffold is free from damage before and during use.
- If unsure **SEEK ADVICE** from a certified scaffolder or DoL (Department of Labour).
